Programs regulations for Minors

The following regulations are intended for minors.

Students must not:

- 1) violate the law in Canada.
- 2) possess or use of any illegal substances.
- 3) consume of any alcoholic beverages or smoke tobacco products.
- 4) possess or use firearms and other weapons such as knives and swords.
- 5) operate any motor vehicles, motorcycles, marine vessels, and aircrafts.
- 6) engage in sexual orientation with his/her peers. (lodging in same room with opposite sex)
- 7) have sleepovers without the permission of the hostfamily.
- 8) return home after the following time.(except with the hostfamily or authorized adults)

Student's Age	Sunday to Thursday	Friday and Saturday
12-13 years old	home for dinner(usually 6:00pm)	8:00pm
14-15 years old	home for dinner(usually 6:00pm)	9:00pm
16-17 years old	home for dinner(usually 6:00pm)	10:00pm
18 years old	home for dinner(usually 6:00pm)	11:00pm

Students who do not follow the above regulations after three warnings will be withdrawn from All Seasons program. In such cases, All Seasons has the right to terminate the contract of the program without advanced notice. The program cost (including homestay fee and support fee) is not subjected to a refund.

Students must:

- 9) act with manner and have respect for others at accepting institutions.
- 10) attend classes every day, and complete assignments. Students must follow the rules and guidance of the accepting institutions.

- 11) maintain the expected grades at accepting institutions.
- 12) stay away from the facilities that are unsuitable for minors, such as adult theaters, bars, pawnshops, etc.
- 13) not participate in extreme sports with high risks, such as bungee jumping, sky diving, etc.
- 14) respect his/her hostfamily, and consider himself/herself as a family member during his/her stay.
- 15) follow the house rules, and offer to help light household chores when possible.
- 16) keep the provided room clean and organized.
- 17) respect the privacy of the hostfamily.
- 18) consult with All Seasons if there are concerns related to participating institutions, programs, or hostfamilies. The rearrangement of participating institutions, programs, and homestay is prohibited without the permission of All Seasons.
- 19) inform and obtain permission from the hostfamily and All Seasons for all travel plans during his/her stay.
- 20) report and obtain permission from the hostfamily when going out with friends. Students are not allowed to stay out overnight without the host's approval.
- 21) not participate in religious/political activities.
- 22) not have body piercings or tattoos done during his/her stay.
- 23) obtain a permission from the host if the student wishes to invite friends over, or to visit a friend's house.

The above regulations apply not only to language school programs and homestay arrangements, but also to students who wish to partake in All Seasons support programs.
